Project overview

-  150 MW storage capacity for up to six hours
 -  5-7 hectares
 -  Freehold property south of Bryne Road adjacent to the Western Power Muchea Substation, approximately 3km north of Muchea.
- The location was selected due to its proximity to the existing Muchea Substation, where the project will connect.

-  The battery received Development Approval from the Shire of Chittering in November 2022 and was successful in bidding for the Federal Government Capacity Investment Scheme in 2025.
- The project will begin construction by upgrading Bryne Road in October 2025 then main site works commencing in January 2026.

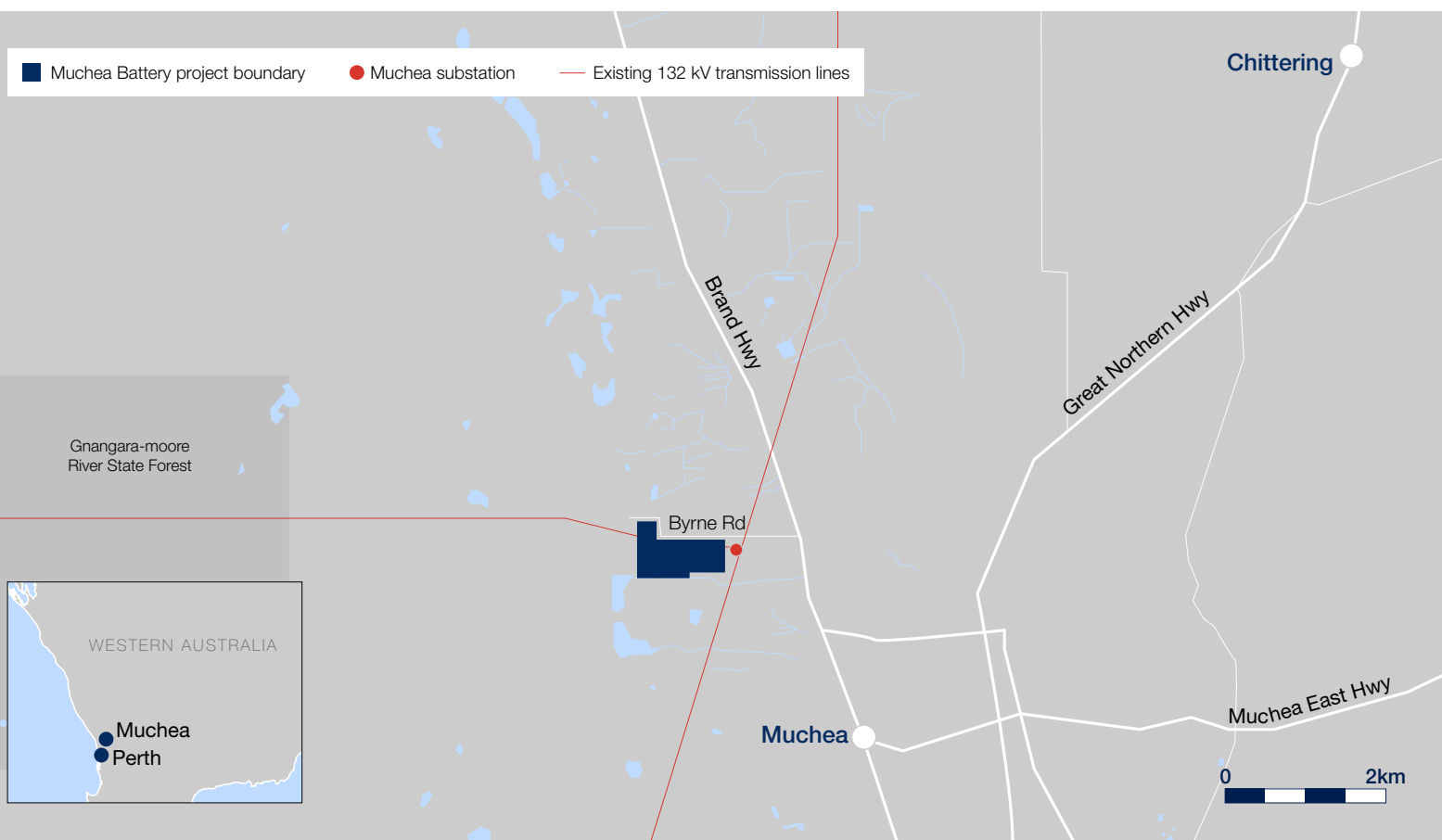

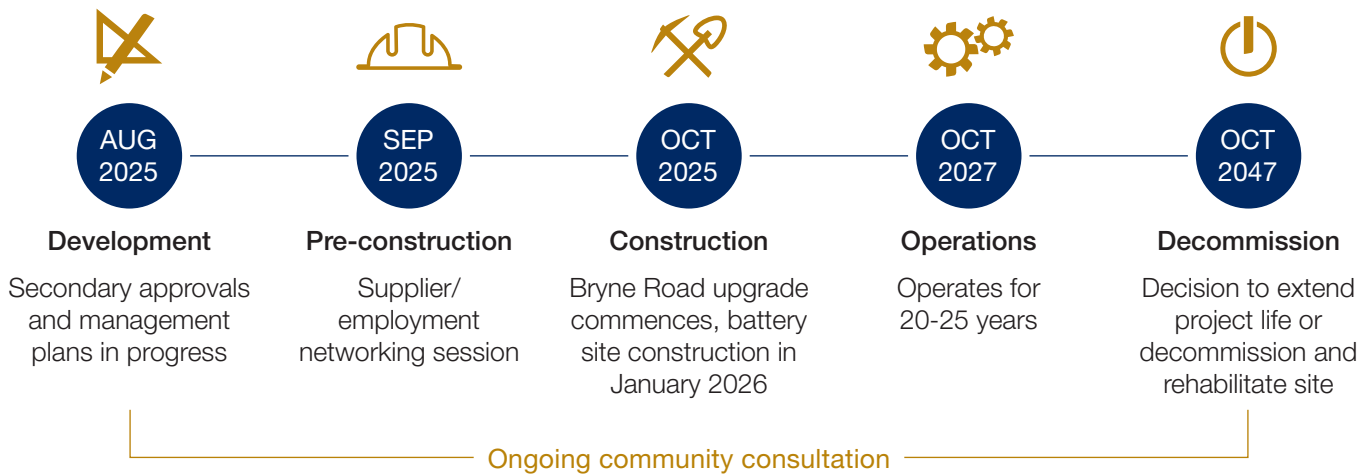
